

SUBJECT: ADVANCE INSTRUCTIONS FOR SUBJECTS WITH PROJECT/PRACTICAL

COMPONENT

1.0 PROJECTS

The 2018 KCSE examinations will start with subjects with a project component. This is scheduled to start in the month of January, 2018 with the Agriculture subject (443/3) project as per the 2018 KCSE timetable which will be available in the KNEC website.

- 1.1 The Kenya National Examinations Council wishes to inform as follows;
 - **1.1.1** The advance instructions for subjects with project /practical component for the 2018 KCSE examination will be posted online for the administration of the project work as per the 2018 KCSE examination timetable;
 - 1.1.2 Sub County Directors of Education (for private candidates) and Principals with candidates registered for subjects listed below are required to log on to the KNEC website: www.knec-portal.ac.ke and click on 2018 projects button to download all the instructions related to the subjects the candidates are registered for;
 - **1.1.3** The Sub County Directors of Education (for private candidates) and Principals /Subject teachers should log in to the KNEC Project portal using the user code for the examination centre and password to download the respective examination instructions for administration of the project.

- **1.1.4** Candidates scores will be keyed online on the projects portal for candidates registered for **441/3**, **442/3**, **443/3**,**444/2**, **445/2**,**446/2**, **451/3** as indicated in project schedule table after which the portal will be closed and shall not be accessible.
 - The **Marking Scheme for Computer Studies (451/3)** will be uploaded in the KNEC projects portal by **15**th **September, 2018** for the Sub County Directors of Education (for private candidates) and Principals/Subject teachers to download.
- 1.1.5 Over the years, the Kenya National Examinations Council has noted that the County Directors of Education (for private candidates) and Principals /Subject teachers do not key the candidate's scores as required. Please note, the Kenya National Examination Council will not process nor release candidates examination results without the project, practical, oral, aural scores.
- **1.1.6** The Kenya National Examinations Council will be monitoring the status and the progress of all **projects** for the candidates who registered for the 2018 KCSE examination in the schools at different times as per the examination time table.
- **1.1.7** The schools are expected to compile and keep the progress report for all the candidates project work to be presented to the monitoring officers.
- 1.1.8 It is the responsibility of the Sub County Directors of Education and Principals to ensure that the candidates' scores are keyed. Failure to do so shall attract a penalty fee of five hundred shillings (Kes. 500) per candidate.

All Sub County Directors of Education and Principals are asked to note that the examination materials remain **confidential** and should be treated as such.

2.0 PRACTICALS

2.1 Group IV Subjects

- 2.1.1 The advance instructions for 442/2 and 451/2 practical examinations will be uploaded on the schools project portal to enable schools to prepare materials in time for the examinations by 30th September, 2018.
- 2.2 Group V Subjects (Orals and Aurals)
 - 2.2.1 The keying of candidates scores for subjects with the oral and aural component French (501/3), German (502/3), Arabic (503/3), Kenyan Sign Language (504/3), and Music (511/1) shall be done by the assessors after the assessment of the candidates on the examination day.
