1. $406+11=$

2. $915+14=$

a. Place value chart with single regrouping (carry over)

Example

$615+16=$

hundreds	Tens	Ones
	1	
6	1	5
+	1	6
6	3	1



5 ones plus 6 ones = 11 **regroup** - ones and tens 1 ones and 1 tens

Write 1 ones and carry over 1 ten to tens column

Add 1 tens + 1 tens = 1 tens = 3 tens records in tens column

Drop the 6 hundreds.

Activity

1. $914 + 28 =$

hundreds	Tens	Ones

2. $519 + 18 =$

hundreds	Tens	Ones



C. Adding using doubles

When adding using doubles add the two similar numbers first then add the third number.

Example

a. $7 + 7 + 8 =$



$$14 + 8 = 22$$

Activity

1. $6 + 7 + 6 =$

2. $5 + 9 + 9 =$

D. ADDING USING BREAKING APART

Breaking apart is expanding.

Adding three-digit number using breaking apart - (expanding)

Example

453

+415

868

400	50	3
+ 400	10	5
800	60	8
8	6	8
