Gumboots are also known as rain boots or rubber boots.



They are highly useful, especially at any construction site, industrial area, chemical factory, mining industry, farm land or any other work place. They go along way to ensuring the safety of ones feet from falling objects which would otherwise cause an injury.

Wet and muddy places can be tricky to walk on because they are slippery. Gumboots lessen the risk of falls as they have specialised soles that are slip-resistant even in the most adverse condition. Because of their comfort, the wearer is productive even after working for long hours.

While someone is working with harsh substances like acids, chemicals etc, there are possibilities of getting burnt. Rubber safety footwear provides an effective barriers between feet and dangerous substances, hence eliminating the risk of burns.

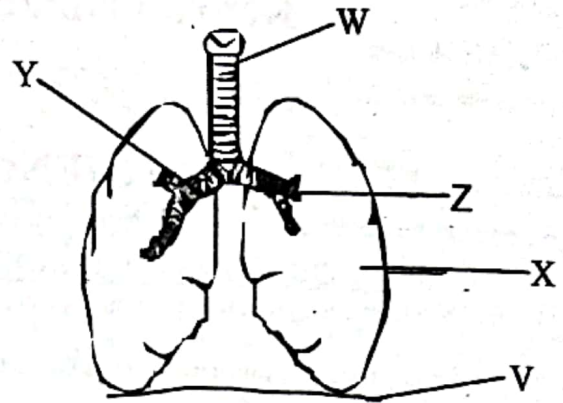

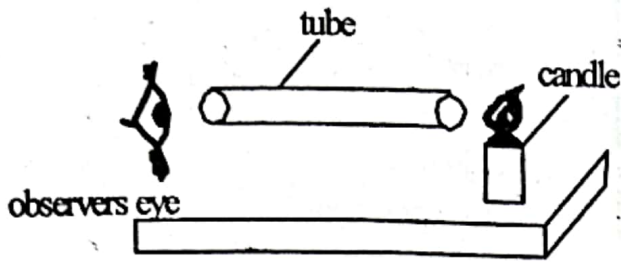
